


The Policy Committee met on January 15th to review PRESS Policy Update 120

- PA 104-32 - New law requires districts to offer age appropriate Mental Health Screenings to Students in grades 3-8
 - beginning with the 2027-2028 school year
 - families can opt out of screening
 - P.A. 104-20 - eliminates the requirement for evaluations to consider growth as a significant factor. This must to be negotiated with NEAT to make any changes to our current plan.


